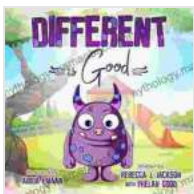

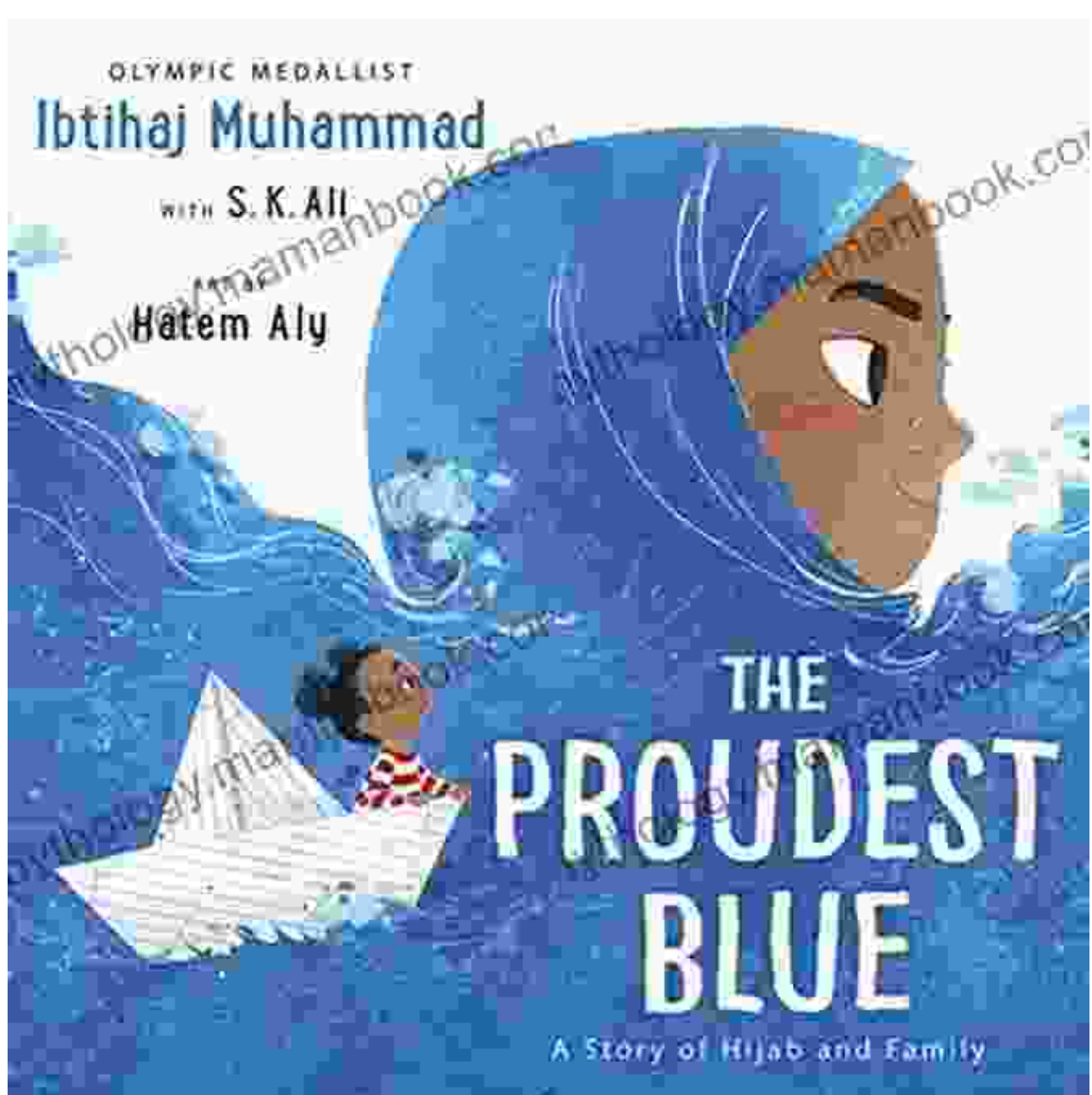
## **I Am Enough**

### **The Proudest Blue**

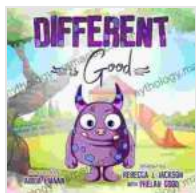

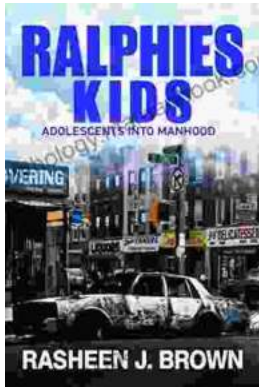
