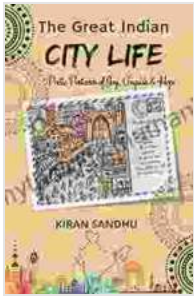

Drowns the tender reed.

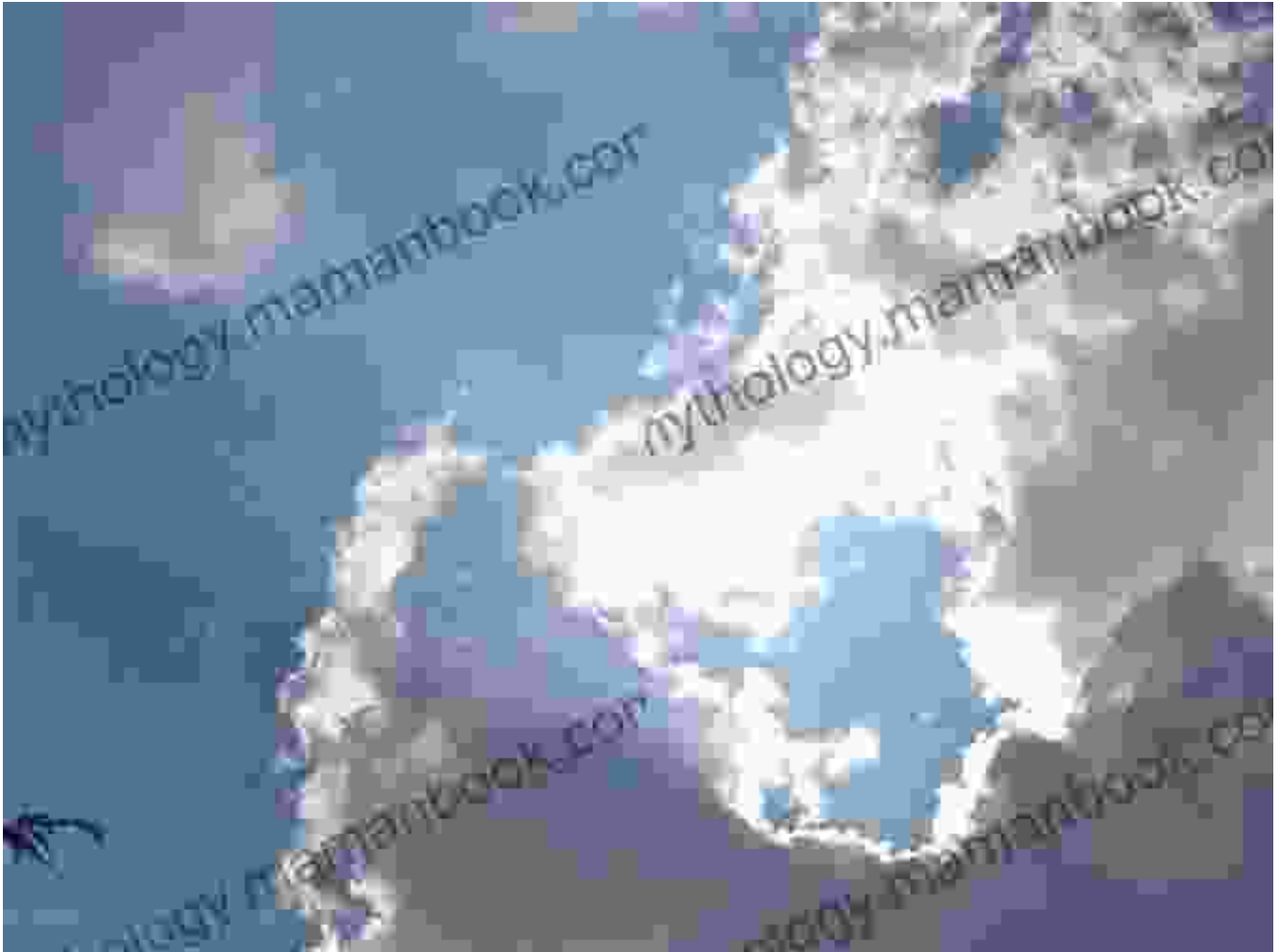
Some say love, it is a razor that

A Tapestry of Emotions

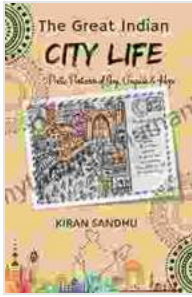

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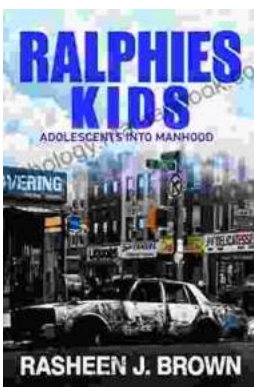


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
